What is the ETS Registry?

'Bank' for emission allowances (EUA) *▶NEa is responsible for Dutch part*

For whom?

- Companies with ETS obligation (Industrial, Aviation & Maritime)
- Voluntary participants (e.g. financials)

What is a MOHA?

MOHA = Maritime Operator Holding Account

Account at the ETS Registry for companies in the maritime sector

➢ For maritime companies attributed to the Netherlands, the NEa is responsible





What can I do with a MOHA?

1. Transfer/receive EUAs (emission allowances) to/from other accounts

2. Enter carbon emissions (until 31 March 2025)

3. Surrender EUAs (until 30 September 2025)





What people do I need?

All transactions need at least 2 people: **1 initiator** and **1** approver

There are 4 user roles:

- A. Initiator
- B. Approver
- C. Initiator + approver
- D. Read only

First checks by NEa

After submitting the web-form, the NEa will check if your company can apply for a MOHA:

- Is it attributed to the Netherlands?
- Is it an ISM company or registered owner?

Yes & yes? Then the NEa will e-mail you asking for the required documents:

• Some about the company

- Some about the users of the account
- Documents may need to be certified and legalized
